1.	Do you have a boiler for home heating? If the answer is yes, you might be subject to backflow protection. Residential boilers that do not use chemicals as corrosion control are permitted. If you do use chemicals, you are required to have an RPZ, and that device testable and needs to be certified by a plumber every three years.
	If you <u>DO NOT</u> have a boiler, or have a boiler that does not use chemicals, check this box.
5.	Do you have a water well on the property used for <u>ANY</u> purpose? If the answer is yes, you must verify (by signing this document) that it is not connected anywhere on your property to the city water source.
