Public Hearings:

A. Special Use Permit – Eggers Excavating

Iamurri opened the Public Hearing at 7:02 p.m.

Brad Walch spoke on behalf of Eggers Excavating to request permission to mine sand at 1825 N Graham Rd. The mine will provide sand to local construction projects as needed. Two sand pits will be dug, which will be turned into ponds in accordance with the ordinance, and the property will be sold for development. An estimated 100,000+ yards of sand is to be removed from the site. Sika stated that the Saginaw County Road Commission has no objection with the use of Graham and Geddes Roads to haul sand from the site. The applicant anticipates most traffic from the site to exit south on Graham to M-46. Dale Krueger of 1822 N Graham Rd spoke in support of the project. He stated that there have been no issues thus far with the

trucks coming and going to clear the property. Walch stated there will be anywhere up to 100 trucks entering and exiting the site daily. Discussion took place regarding the start date and time period of the permit.

Iamurri closed the public hearing at 7:29 p.m.

Motion by Yockey, supported by Curry to approve the special use permit to mine sand at 1825 N Graham with the following contingencies.

1. The special use permit for sand mining will commence on December 1, 2023 and conclude on May 31, 2024.
2. Operations will take place between the hours of 7:00 am and 6:00 pm on weekdays only.
 - a. No operations shall take place on weekends or holidays.
3. Per section 18.25f, Performance Bond, the applicant must provide a security bond or deposit in the amount of \$36,000 for any road repairs or site reclamation necessary after completion of the permitted activity.
 - a. The property and surrounding roads will be inspected at the beginning and end of the permit period to determine if the bond will need to be used.
